This tour is an invitation to learn about man’s longstanding activity in Carpentras and the Comtat Venaissin. Discussion of the “*cauquières*” basins where the leatherworkers soaked the animal skins, near the Auzon river, of the paper mills, the fabric mills ...

Carpentras was famous for silk work and pewter work, of which no physical vestiges remain. However, an old seed and hulling business, the Graineterie Roux, where time stands still, is the subject of a fascinating guided visit.

The current recipe for the famous “Berlingot” can be traced back to the 19th century and Gustave Eysserice. Visit one of the last artisanal Berlingot production plants, see the many colors and taste the many flavors. Walking circuit.

Comtadin traditions and savoir-faire have been handed down for generations ...

Wrought iron workers, stoneworkers, sculptors, past and present, have left countless influences and continue to work today. On the Builders’ Road, the Campanile Road, or the Water Heritage Road.
